## New brews

*Denmark has more breweries per capita than anywhere in Europe. Its spirit of innovation means we're here for the beer*

Denmark's Carlsberg brewery, founded in 1847, has recently been challenged on two fronts. Firstly, by a surge of more than 100 smart young breweries-cum-bars, including Copenhagen's Amager Bryghus, Brewpub and Nørrebro Bryghus (pictured). Secondly, by the rise of the 'gypsy brewer', a type of wandering guest brewer that creates their own beers in other people's breweries. Twice awarded Danish brewer of the year, Mikkel Borg Bjergsø is the master of this game; his creations under the name Mikkeller are bubbling with innovation. His latest offering is a limited edition created with design studio Femmes Regionales and poetically named 'Drink Your Sorrows Away'.
